It is the Society For Companion Animals' (SFCA) policy not to discuss the status or condition of any dogs with anyone outside of the foster or anyone involved in direct care or adoption process of the dogs.

AIRPORT RULES:

For the safety and flight operations reasons, dogs are to remain inside AA Global Priority Building. Dogs are to be left inside their crates unless for inspection or cleaning.

First Volunteer Shift — When dogs are out of their crate keep the dog inside the building. While the crate is being inspected, the volunteer holding the dog needs to check the dog's eyes and nose for any discharge of mucus. If mucus or blood is seen, notify Tawana immediately.

Second Volunteer Shift – A volunteer on this shift may feed/water/walk a dog outside one at a time and clean up any poop with a poop bag. Bags are to be disposed of properly. This is the only time a dog can be walked outside the building.
